This case includes but is not limited to blind spot indicator issues defective cells in the lithium battery, multiple recalls with no parts available.

If either party does not appear by 9:00 am, the hearing will be held in that party's absence.

CONTINUANCES:

The Board shall grant up to a 30-day extension of time to schedule a hearing pursuant to RSA 3S7-D:4, IV and Arb 203.06

if a party demonstrates exigent circumstances, which shall include:

- 1. hospitalization,
- serious illness,
- 3. incarceration,
- 4. death of a family member, or
- 5. any other unforeseeable circumstances beyond the party's control.

All requests for continuances shall:

- 1. be in writing
- 2. be received no later than 5 working days prior to the hearing date, and
- 3. shall include:
 - the reason for the request; and
 - optional dates when the party shall be available
